

Margaret 'Peg' Davis 1915-2013

SENECA — Margaret "Peg" Davis, 97, of Seneca, passed away Saturday, April 13, at Rivershores Rehabilitation and Nursing Center in Marseilles.

Peg was born July 27, 1915, in Vienna Township, Grundy County, to Francis and Gertrude (Judge) O'Malley. She married Robert J. Davis on Sept. 10, 1954, at St. Patrick's Rectory in Seneca. He passed away Aug. 11, 1982.

She retired from E.I. DuPont Seneca Works after 38 years of service in 1974. She was a professional certified secretary.
